A.O.S. Deposit Information

One-Day Programs

During the 2008-2009 school year, we are charging the following prices for day-long programs:

- \$10.00 per student (includes A.O.S.-provided lunch)
 - **Deposit:** \$5.00 per pre-registered child.
- \$7.00 per student (you and the students bring your own lunch)
 - **Deposit:** \$3.50 per pre-registered child.

**There is not a charge for chaperones* or teachers for one-day programs.

Overnight Programs

During the 2008-2009 school year, we are charging the following prices for two-day, one-night programs:

- \$50.00 per student
 - **Deposit:** \$10.00 per pre-registered child.
- \$50.00 per chaperone*
 - **Deposit:** No deposit.
- School teachers are free.
 - **Deposit:** No deposit.

*We do ask that there be no more than one (1) chaperone to every five (5) to eight (8) students. We also require the chaperones be at least 18 and out of high school.
